### Whale Watching 1:30 PM - 5:00 PM

We are hitting the migration during its busiest time - hundreds of Grey Whales travel along the Laguna Beach coastline and within minutes of Newport Harbor. Along with viewing Grey Whales, you can expect to see dolphins, sea lions, and marine birds. Killer Whales, sharks, and many other marine creatures may also be observed. **Bring: Warm jacket, flat shoes, sunglasses and a camera!**

### Behind the Scenes at the Aquarium of the Pacific 12:45 PM - 4:30 PM

Venture “behind the scenes” in this private tour! You’ll also get to go above the aquarium’s largest exhibit, Tropical Reef, to feed the fish! ### The Three Pier Bike Tour 1:45 PM - 5:15 PM

### Hike in Laguna Coast Wilderness Park 1:15 PM - 4:45 PM

Laguna Coast Wilderness Park lies within some of the last remaining coastal canyons in Southern California. Forty miles of trails lead the visitors through oak and sycamore woodlands and up onto ridges with expansive scenic coastal vistas. Rocky bluffs tower over the canyon trails. Visitors to Laguna Coast Wilderness Park can see California as it has existed for thousands of years. This is a strenuous, intermediate hike with a substantial climb from sea level to a ridge in Laguna Coast Wilderness Park. **Bring: Hiking shoes or sneakers, and a hat is recommended!**
